GENERAL

- Vehicles are not allowed on the school premises at any time during school days. Only Out-weekend the parents are allowed to enter the premises with a vehicle to collect the children's goods.
- Parents are to please confirm anything the learner tells them. If a learner is becoming sick at home the parent must call the office immediately.

PAYMENTS AND FINANCES

- January admissions. All parents and learners are to report to the dining hall to pay and collect a hostel card.
- **NO MONEY - NO SPACE.**
- All Payments are to be made on or before the 15th of every month for that month to avoid penalty
- There will be a penalty fee of R200, 00 for all late payments.
- Only Swipe/ EFT will be accepted.
- If payments are **TWO** months in arrears the child will be expelled from the hostel with immediate effect.
- Fees are payable in advance.
- February's payment **MUST** be paid by the end of January or before 15th February.
- Fees are divided into 11 equal payments.
- **NO** learner will be able to stay in the hostel during any out weekends if any school fees are outstanding.
- A penalty fee of R1000, 00 per learner must be paid if they stay during any out weekends.

PUNCTUALITY & OUT WEEKENDS

- Each out-weekend there will be **NO** classes on that Friday.
- Learners may be collected on the Thursday between 13:30 and 18:00.
- All Learners may return from 14:00 but **MUST** be back before 18:00 on Sunday evenings. A penalty fee of R200.00 will be given for every hour later.
- Learners are to be signed out and in again upon return to the hostel.
- An indemnity form **MUST** be signed for any persons other than yourselves giving them permission to fetch your child.

LEARNERS RULES Part 2

- No cell phones. Any learner found in possession of a cell phone will be confiscated. All confiscated cell phones will only be handed out once a fine of R1000, 00 is received. No cell phone fines will be added to your statement. Please note all cell phones should be collected within 3 months of the confiscating date. The School or any of the personal will not be held responsible for any loss or damaged to the cell phone after 3 months.
- Leaving the school grounds without permission.
- Your uniform must be worn with pride!
- With signing in and signing out, it is **COMPULSARY** for learners to wear their uniform.
- Boys: All boys must have short hair and be shaven at all times, no jewellery.
- Girls: 1. The colour of the hair may only be black.
2. The braid may not be thicker than 5mm; the length of the braid may not exceed 40cm; it must also lie flat against the head and not stand up in all directions.
3. All hairstyles that touch the shoulders must be fastened back away from the face and must be kept neat and well maintained.
